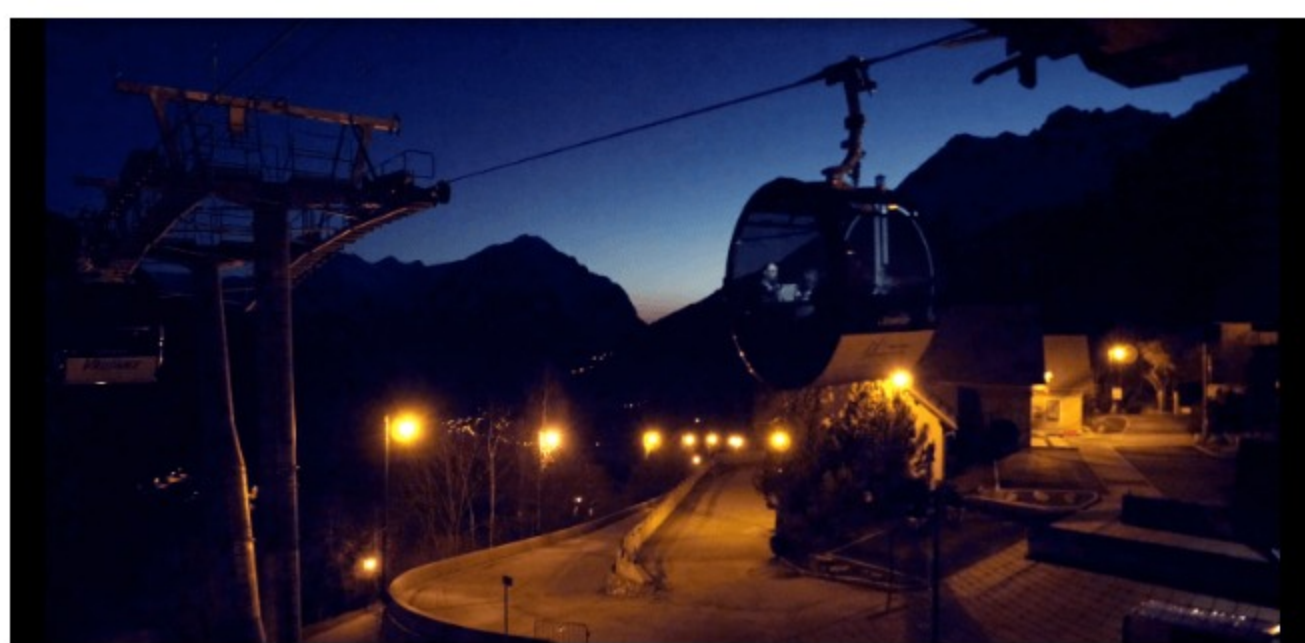
Where's Already Open to Ski or Board at the Start of November 2019?

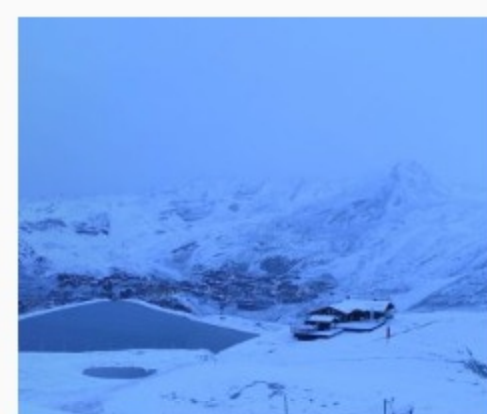

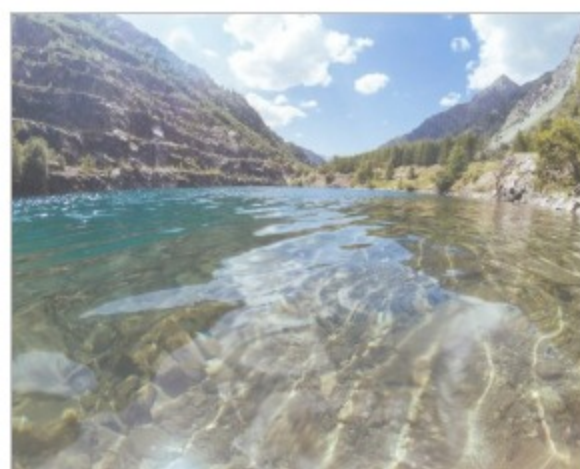

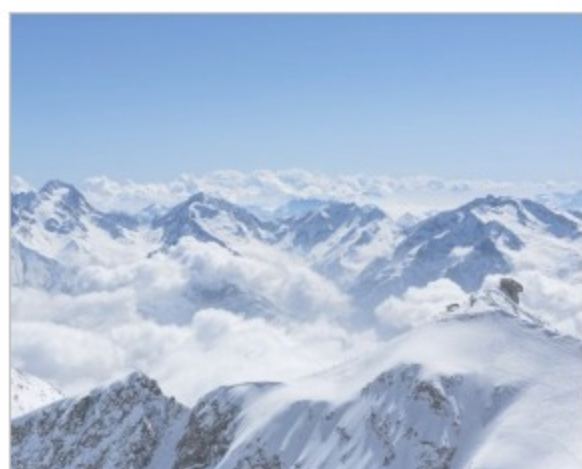
